It left me speechless ... then changed

A friend challenged me, "I dare you, for one week, to not use the word 'bless' when you pray for someone."

"Easy enough," I thought. And it was easy until the next time I prayed for someone. "Lord, please bless ... Oh, wait, I can't use 'bless.' Hmmmmm. What now?"

I was speechless. I didn't know what to say. I actually had to stop, think about the person, think about their situation, think about their family, think about their current struggles and their need.

I actually had to think about what I was saying when I prayed!

Suddenly I realized how much of my praying was little more than a half-brained recitation of names prefaced with "Lord, bless..."

Now I had to think about them. Where are they spiritually, physically, emotionally, in their home, in their family? What do I pray specifically that will "bless" them?

That was tough because I know prayer is not about getting God to do my will. It's about me aligning with His will and praying for His will to be done on earth as it is in Heaven. What would be the Lord's will for them so I can align my prayer with His will?

Now, I had to pray about what to pray about! "Lord, what is your will for my friend (or enemy)? How do You want to bless them so I can pray accordingly?"
