

She was going to visit an American girl she met in Taiwan and had been frantically studying English to be ready. As the conversation turned to spiritual matters, I found she was from a Buddhist family (most common in Taiwan) but had become a Christian. Wow! You guessed it. The friend she was visiting came to Taiwan as a missionary and introduced her to Jesus.

As we talked – through painfully broken English and Google translator – I discovered she had a lot to learn about English and following Jesus - don't we all – but she was pointed in the right direction and excitedly moving forward.

As I struggled to figure out what she was saying, I couldn't help but think, "This girl's eternal destiny was changed because a young, single American woman said, 'I will go' and others said, 'We will send you." How do you think this Taiwanese girl would answer the questions some Christians ask?

Questions like, "Is sending missionaries worth the cost and sacrifices? Do they really make a positive difference?" You know this young lady next to me would enthusiastically shout, "YES! and YES!" Or, more likely, "Shí! Shí!"
